Good afternoon.

APAS recently created postcards for the RMAA Convention that promote four APAS projects, so I thought I'd send them to you as an update for your Council.

**1) APAS farmland ownership project** – we want to make it easier to track who buys and owns farmland in Saskatchewan and where the money is coming from.

**2) New APAS Farmers and Food Prices report (coming out in June)** – it shows that farmers and ranchers get very little back from high grocery store prices.

**3) APAS NPF Task Force update** – APAS sent our first ideas to the provincial government as they start to negotiate on the next 5-year SCAP agreement.

**4) APAS export sales report** – we want Canada to track grain export sales for farmers so they can sell their grain at better prices.

Would Big Arm's Council like a 15-minute update from APAS sometime over the next few months before harvest starts?
