THE CHALLENGES



MODERNIZING BRM PROGRAMS

Current programs must evolve to address trade risk, tariff risk, rising input costs, and delayed support payments.

LOST VALUE-ADDED POTENTIAL

Too much production leaves Canada as raw commodities instead of higher-value processed exports.
